

CATTLE

- All exhibitors must pay an exhibitor fee to the Society or enclose exhibitor fee of \$8 with entry list.
- In lieu of entry fee, 10 per cent of prize money won will be deducted unless otherwise stated.
- All cattle must be registered at the time of the Show in the name of the exhibitor and pedigrees must be presented at ringside.
- Only animals winning first or second prizes are eligible to compete for Championship prizes.
- **Health:** Requirements for All Cattle Exhibited at Class "A" Fairs. Ontario is a Brucellosis-Free Region. There is no requirement for a negative brucellosis test with 60 days prior to entry into a show or exhibition. Any cattle other than those from a herd under quarantine are eligible to enter a show without restriction.
- No Livestock to be removed from the grounds before 4:30 pm on the day of the show.
- All exhibitors must enter at the Exhibitors Gate on Thomas Street.

GENERAL RULES

DEFINITION OF AN ENTRY

(A) Breeding Classes:

- All registered cattle, whether owned by one person or by more than one person (individually or jointly) which are maintained on one farm or breeding unit, are considered to be the production of one farm or breeding unit.
- In each classification where the same or common interests are involved in more than one beef or dairy breeding operation, such operations are considered ONE Breeding Unit.
- Only one entry per class is eligible from such farm or breeding unit, except the fair may authorize two entries per class in a maximum of two classes, exclusive of the interbreed best udder class.
- All Entries must be owned by and registered in the name of the exhibitor.

(B) Group Classes:

The registration certificate for each respective animal must show the exhibitor as "breeder" and as "owner" – in both cases either as an individual or in partnership. In other words, the exhibitor may be a "joint owner" of an animal and/or the "joint breeder" of an animal. Therefore the animals must be: Owned and bred by the exhibitor, or Jointly owned and bred by the exhibitors, or Owned and jointly bred by the exhibitor, or Jointly owned and jointly bred by the exhibitor.

R.O.P. Requirement and Production Records (B.C.A.) – Performance requirements for specified classes are listed within each classification.

Where performance records are condition of entry, the official records must be available for checking by the exhibition.
