PURPOSE:

4-H INTER-CLUB EXHIBITS / 4-H CLUB EXHIBITS

RULES:

1. Open to Halton 4-H Clubs who have participated in a 2016-2017 club project.
2. Four feet of table space that is 2 ½ feet deep will be provided to each club. Backdrops must be supplied by the club.
3. Exhibits must be planned and prepared by club members on an educational aspect of the club project. The exhibit must have the name of the club clearly shown on the display. 4-H Clubs may place only one exhibitor per project at any Fair in any one year.
4. Exhibits are to be set up in the south end of the Grandstand on Wednesday, September 20 from 6:00 pm-9:00 pm or Thursday, September 21 from 9:00 am-10:30 am. Exhibits must be removed on Sunday, September 24 between 5:00 pm-6:00 pm.
5. **Prize Money:** Grade A - \$30; Grade B - \$25; Grade C - \$20.
Additional Prize: Grand Champion Award - \$10.

6. Exhibits will be judged by score card on the following basis:
 - General Appearance (neat, effective, harmonious, balanced) 20
 - Power to attract and hold attention (original ideas, interesting layout) 25
 - Message (simple, clear, complete, convincing, educational value) 25
 - Unity in presenting message (one central theme, supported, points emphasized) 15
 - Quality of materials (easy to read, well-made, good background materials) 15
