GENERAL RULES:

- All animals must be on the grounds by 9 a.m., Saturday, September 22, 2018
- ****NEW FOR 2018** ALL EXHIBITORS WILL PAY FULL GATE ADMISSION TO GROUNDS. THERE WILL NO LONGER BE ANY PERCENTAGE DEDUCTED FROM PRIZE WINNINGS.**
- Each breeding unit is allowed a maximum of 10 exhibits excluding Breeders Herd.
- All cattle must be owned by and registered at the time of the show in the name of the exhibitor and pedigrees must be presented at ringside.
- All registered cattle, whether owned by one person or by more than one person (individually or jointly) which are maintained on one farm or breeding unit, are considered to be the production of one farm or breeding unit.
- **Health:** Requirements for All Cattle Exhibited at Class "A" Fairs. Ontario is a Brucellosis-Free Region. There is no requirement for a negative brucellosis test with 60 days prior to entry into a show or exhibition. Any cattle other than those from a herd under quarantine are eligible to enter a show without restriction.
- **CFIA TAGS:** Please be aware that all livestock must arrive with CFIA tags, they are to be tagged before they leave the farm. Should they arrive without tags, and the Inspectors discover this, you are putting YOURSELF at risk of a \$1300.00 fine, as well as \$1300.00 for the trucker and another \$1300.00 fine for the H.A.S. The H.A.S. is NOT a tagging station for livestock. Any untagged livestock will not be permitted to show.
- **INSURANCE: **NEW** All livestock/equine exhibitors must provide proof of liability insurance (minimum \$2,000,000) with policy number, name of insurance company and expiry date on entry forms. Photocopies of OEF membership accepted for equine classes/shows.**
- Only animals winning first or second prizes are eligible to compete for Championship prizes.
- No Livestock to be removed from the grounds before 4:30 p.m. on the day of the show.
- All exhibitors must enter at the Exhibitors Gate on Thomas Street
- EXHIBITORS TO PROVIDE OWN STRAW.

CLASS 9 • OPEN BEEF BREEDS (REGISTERED)

Judged on Saturday, September 22, 2018 immediately following Youth Beef Show

SECTION:

1. Bull calf born on or after January 1, 2018, minimum of three months of age on day of judging.
2. Bull, yearling, born January 1 - December 31, 2017
3. Grand Champion Bull and Reserve — Ribbons
4. Female calf born on or after January 1, 2018, minimum of three months of age on day of judging.
5. Female, heifer born April 1, 2016 - December 31, 2017.
6. Female, heifer born January 1 - March 31, 2017.
7. Female, born January 1 - December 31, 2016, with her own 2018, natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Female with calf shall be shown as a unit except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Class 10 (Breeders Herd).
8. Female, born prior to January 1, 2016 with her own 2018 natural, purebred, tattooed calf at foot. Female with calf shall be shown as a unit except that the calf is eligible to be shown as a single animal in Class 10 (Breeders Herd).
9. Grand Champion Female and Reserve — Ribbons
10. Breeders Herd, a group of four (4) animals bred by the exhibitor, both sexes represented. Must be exhibited in previous classes. At least one animal must be owned by the exhibitor. Limited to one exhibit per exhibitor.

Prize money for all classes except Championship classes:

Prizes – \$60, \$50, \$45, \$35, \$30, \$25, \$20.

Entries to be sent to the Secretary by September 17, 2018.

SHOWMANSHIP SECTION

1. **Pre-Junior Section:** Open to boys and girls under 9 years of age as of January 1, 2018.
Prize money - \$10 to all participants
2. **Junior Section:** Open to boys and girls 9 – 12 years of age as of January 1, 2018.
Prize money - \$60, \$50, \$40, \$30 to balance of entries
3. **Intermediate Section:** Open to boys and girls 13-14-15 yrs. of age as of January 1, 2018.
Prize money - \$60, \$50, \$40, \$30 to balance of entries
4. **Senior Section:** Open to boys and girls 16-21 yrs. of age as of January 1, 2018.
Prize money - \$60, \$50, \$40, \$30 to balance of entries
5. **1st year 4-H Beef Showman:** Open to all 1st year 4-H Beef Calf Club members.
Special prize to 1st place, ribbons to balance.

6. Yearling Beef Heifer born Jan 1, 2017 to March 31, 2017
7. Yearling Beef Heifer born April 1, 2017 to December 31, 2017
8. Beef Heifer Calf born January 1, 2018 to April 30, 2018

Champion and Reserve Champion Beef Female – Rosettes.

1st and 2nd place animals from classes 6, 7 & 8 eligible to compete

9. Market Heifer
10. Market Steer

Champion and Reserve Champion Market Animal – Rosettes.

1st and 2nd place animals from classes 9 & 10 eligible to compete
