**Rules and Regulations** 

- The contestant must be able to pedal the tractor without assistance.
- Pedal tractors will be furnished for all participants.
- Contestants must wear shoes.
- The pulling tractor must stay between the lines of pulling lane at all times.

• If the tractor leaves the pulling lane, the distance will be measured from the starting line to the point where the tractor crossed the boundary.

- In case of a tie there will be a pull-off to determine the winner.
- There will be four (4) classes of contestants, they are:
