- ALL EXHIBITORS WILL PAY FULL GATE ADMISSION TO GROUNDS. THERE WILL NO LONGER BE ANY PERCENTAGE DEDUCTED FROM PRIZE WINNINGS.
- INSURANCE: All livestock/equine exhibitors must provide proof of liability insurance (minimum \$2,000,000) with policy number, name of insurance company and expiry date on entry forms.
- All animals to be exhibited MUST bear a CFIA approved tag. A complete list of animal tags anticipated to be exhibited must be submitted with entry forms.
- EXHIBITORS TO PROVIDE OWN STRAW
- Each breed class must have three complete flocks exhibited; if not, they will exhibit in "Any Other Breed" class.
- All entries must be owned by and registered in the name of the exhibitor.
- In the breeding classes only one entry per class is eligible from a farm or breeding unit except an exhibitor may show two entries per class in a maximum of two classes.
- Breeder's Flock (bred and owned by exhibitor).
- All exhibits must be shown in short fleece (staple less than 1 inch or 2.5 cm).
- The number of breeds that may be exhibited by an exhibitor shall be limited to two breeds.

TRUCKS & TRAILERS

BREEDING CLASSES

- 1. Ewe "Yearling" (3rd pair of temporary incisors must be in place). Born and bred in Canada.

- 3. Pair of Ewes (animals must have been shown in the previous two classes). Only one (1) entry per exhibitor.
- 4. Ram "Yearling" (3rd pair of temporary incisors must be in place).
- 5. Ram "Lamb" (1st pair of temporary incisors must be in place).
- 6. Get of Sire (Born the property of the exhibitor). A group of three animals, full mouth milk teeth, by the same sire. Both sexes may be represented. Each animal in the group must have been exhibited in one of the preceding classes.
- 7. Breeder's Flock (Bred and owned by exhibitor). A group of four (4) animals. Both sexes to be represented. Each animal in the group must have been exhibited in one of the preceding classes. All animals in a group to be of one breed.
